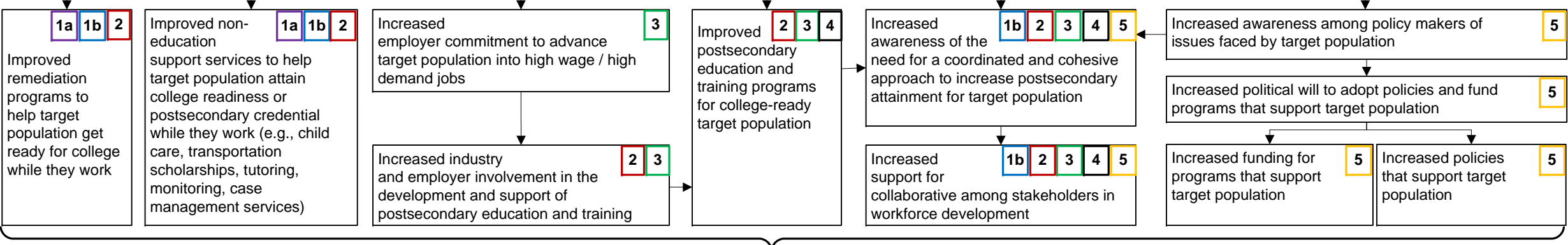

Goal

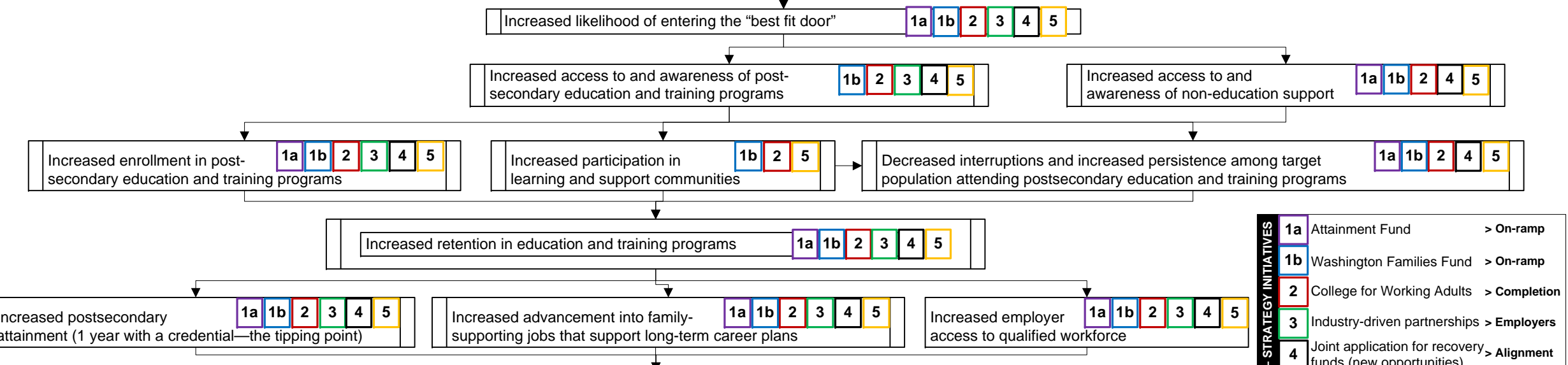
- Shared vision and investment strategy

- Feedback and evaluation mechanisms (TBD)
- Regional employers, educational institutions, workforce development institutions and service providers
- Target population: low-income/low-skilled working adults, who are likely to benefit from postsecondary education and training and address skills shortages**

- Invest in organizations, programs and systems that serve target population
